Institute's Sunday Afternoon Concerts to Continue

The popular Sunday afternoon concerts begun by the Institute last spring will continue throughout the 2009 -2010 season (September through April).

Held in the historic Woman's Club building at 227 North Grove Street in Eustis, the concerts begin at 3:00 PM and end at 5:00 PM. A forty-five minute intermission allows all patrons to enjoy a tea prepared and served by members of the Woman's Club. There is plenty of parking behind the building, and it is handicapped-accessible.

New this year are reserved seating, youth scholarships, and a partnership with the Stetson University's School of Music for the most of the performers.

In August, patrons will be able to reserve their seats for one performance or for all six concerts at the Woman's Club. Youth scholarships will be available for each concert. These scholarships will be awarded through public and private music teachers and the awards will be based on need and interest, rather than talent. Five of the six Sunday afternoon Community Concerts will feature performers from Stetson's School of Music. Many patrons will remember the wonderful vocal and piano concert presented in March 2009 by four talented Stetson musicians. The first concert of the season will feature Friends of the Institute president, Dr. Gail Burch on the harpsichord.
