All seven concerts have reserved seating available. Six concerts will be presented at the Woman's Club of Eustis building, 277 N. Center Street in Eustis. For these six Sunday Afternoon Concerts, seats can be reserved for single performances or for the entire series. A seating chart is on the website. These concerts are presented every fourth Sunday of the month from September through April (excluding December and March). Tickets are \$10 per concert for Institute members and \$15 for nonmembers. We are working on a surprise performance for December.

The Barto Prize Concert is scheduled for March 20, 2010, 7:30 PM, at the State Theatre, 109 North Bay Street, Eustis. Tickets are \$35 and \$20 for students. Those who have attended past Tzimon Barto performances know to reserve seats early for the best selection. There will be only one concert in 2010.
